Open to KTM and Husqvarna Adventure Riders with the following eligible bikes: KTM 390 Adventure, 500 EXC-F, 640, 690, 790, 790R, 890, 890R, 950, 990, 1050, 1090R, 1190R, 1190R, 1290 & 1290R, and Husqvarna FE 501, 701 Enduro & Norden 901 models.

The Ride Out is tailored to suit a wide range of rider abilities, from those in their first years of Adventure riding up to seasoned Adventure riders.

For the 2024 Tracktion Motorcycles Ride Out, the route will cover some epic North Canterbury terrain featuring stunning farmland, endless metal roads and special access to multiple private properties that all adventure riders dream of. Two action packed days will see adventurers treated to a course set by local experts who are all adventure riders themselves and excited to showcase the stunning landscape they call their backyard.

Designed with the larger capacity KTM & Husqvarna adventure range in mind, as well as the variety of rider abilities, the route will include a mix of tar sealed roads, back country roads, metal roads, private land access. farm trails and much more.

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THE ROUTE »


The Tracktion Motorcycles Ride Out 2024 is set to explore the upper North Canterbury region from Christchurch up through Okuku Pass, into Waikari and then through to Hanmer Springs. Then into Marlborough and the Clarence River Valley and on to Kaikoura.

Kickstarting the Ride Out leaving Christchurch, the first day will feature river tracks, flowing gravel backroads and back country stations, with some water crossings thrown in for good fun! You'll follow some well-known metal roads and river tracks which will lead us to the first private farms in the Waikari region. This will encompass flowing farm tracks, exciting single tracks and a challenge section will lead us to our first overnight stop in Hanmer Springs.

Day 2 starts out with a lap through the scenic Lochiel Station and then on to Waiau and up Inland Road and into Muzzle Station. If you haven't been to the Muzzle Station yet, this is a rare treat. On the way in we will divert onto some lesser know tracks and then head to our overnight stop on the Station. Here we will have dinner and then breakfast after which we will head off for some more adventure on Day 3. Day 3 will see us eventually heading out of Muzzle Station via some more single track and then off to our final farm before we end up in Kaikoura for our last night.

The combined routes will provide a varied range of terrain designed for the larger capacity adventure bikes, with a few medium challenging sections which is sure to make any adventure rider smile ear-to-ear.

The aim of the Tracktion Motorcycles Ride Out is to be suitable for adventure riders of all abilities. It will consist of a Main Route made up of a mixture of winding back country roads, metal roads, highway and well-formed farm tracks. There are a few shorter challenging sections on the Main Route which will be highlighted at the daily rider briefings with an option to detour if you choose to.





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NAVIGATION INFORMATION »

The Ride Out is tailored to suit a range of rider abilities. In order to cater for this variety of levels, each day's course can be traversed in your own time, at your own pace, with sweep riders to assist with any riders finding the terrain or navigation challenging.

Lead riders depart before the group each morning to ensure the tracks are clear, plus sweep riders bring up the tail end of the pack to assist with any issues that may arise throughout the day. A daily route sheet will be supplied at the nightly rider briefings; however the main source of navigation comes in the form of GPS track files. **Therefore, it is mandatory that riders have a GPS unit or Smartphone with navigation capabilities for the event.**

Riders are free to depart each morning between 8.30-9.00am, in their own time and on their own agenda. Suggested lunch and fuel stops will be advised at the daily rider briefings.



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RIDE OUT SUPPORT »

As outlined earlier, the support offered on the Tracktion Motorcycles Ride Out is where the value for the rider comes in. More information on all the provided support will be given to those who register for the event in the form of a REGISTERED RIDER DOSSIER, but to recap again on what the Ride Out offers:

LEAD/SWEEP RIDERS. A number of lead and sweep riders will ride alongside participants to ensure safety and support to riders when required. All Lead and Sweep Riders are experienced adventure riders and will be available to assist with any issues that may arise along the way.

MEDIC SUPPORT. We will have a trained paramedic supporting the team on the Ride Out to assist and advise with any rider injuries.

TECH SUPPORT. We will have a Tracktion Motorcycles mechanic as part of the support team available to advise or assist with issues that may arise along the way that you cannot fix yourselves.

4WD RECOVERY VEHICLE. There will be a 4WD backup recovery/support vehicle following the group daily to provide support, assist with any issues, and provide personnel or motorcycle recovery that may be required during the Ride Out.

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ACCOMMODATION & MEALS »

ACCOMMODATION - All accommodation for the Ride Out is included in the entry fee! Once you register, you will receive a REGISTERED RIDER DOSSIER which will outline all the accommodation venues and where the nightly Riders Briefing and Dinners will take place. Accommodation is on a shared basis, once registered you can request to share a room with your mates or be allocated a shared room and meet some new friends. We will also have some single accommodation options available, if you prefer your own company. (Or want to avoid snoring \bigcirc)

<u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Accommodation for Muzzle Station is a mixture of bunk rooms and shearing quarters.

DINNERS – Nightly dinners are included in the Ride Out fee, so after a long day on the bike, you don't need to worry about having to hunt down some chow - we've got it sorted for you. (Dietary requirements will be catered for and you can specify this at registration).

BREAKFASTS – For Saturday & Sunday are included in the Ride Out fee at the overnight accommodation .

LUNCHES – For Day 1 & Day 2 we will have dedicated lunch stops in local towns, however lunches are at the riders own expense and responsibility. Lunch meals and additional snacks/drinks are not covered in the Ride Out fee. On <u>DAY 3</u> we will be given a cut lunch from Muzzle Station (this is included in your Ride Out Fee).

RIDER LUGGAGE »

Riders will need a bike mounted luggage system suitable for carrying changes of clothing for 3 days, casual wear for evenings, toiletries etc. A full suggested gear list will be provided in the REGISTERED RIDER DOSSIER for registered riders. We suggest a rear or side mounted soft luggage systems or dry bags. For the overnight stop at Muzzle Station, we will be able to transport your sleeping bag and mattress (if required). Hard case paniers are suitable for the Ride Out however we recommend soft luggage over hard cases for rider safety and potential gear damage in the event of a dropped motorcycle.
